



TRAINING VISA (Schengen Visa with permission to work in Germany)

Please submit your application for a visa for training purpose to the German Embassy only when the training takes place in Germany. You can apply for this training visa when

- you take part in an international/scientific/research exchange programme
- you are sent by your international company to a sister company
- you are to be instructed in electronic programmes /machines which your company ordered in Germany

Please be aware that

- the stay for training with this kind of visa is allowed only for 3 months per year
- you have to apply for an Employment visa when the training is planned for more than 90 days .

Please note that your residence permit (employment pass, dependant's pass, student pass or blue IC) for Singapore has to be valid at least another three months with re-entry permit.

Applications must be submitted **in person when first time** and cannot be submitted earlier than 3 months before travel date. The visa process is normally finalised within **four working days** upon submission of your **complete** visa application.

For some nationalities (e.g. Afghanistan, Irak, Iran, Jordan, Libanon, Nigeria, Pakistan, Syria, Somalia, Sri Lanka and Sudan) the processing time of a visa application takes approximately **10 working days**.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that his/her application is submitted in time. Bad planning on the applicant's side does not automatically warrant exceptional handling from our side.

The fee for the processing of the visa application of an adult is the equivalent of € 60.00 **and must be paid in cash in SGD**.

All documents must be submitted in **original as well as one copy**. Copies will not be made by Embassy staff.

This information is not a concluding list of documents. Further documentation can - at any times - be requested by the Embassy or provided by the applicant.

Besides, the submission of the above mentioned documents does not guarantee the issue of a visa (in time). Submission of an incomplete set of documentation will lead to a refusal of your visa application. Once a visa has been issued the purpose of the trip may not be altered. Your passport has to remain in the Embassy until collection of the visa. There is no legal right for visa and there is no urgent/express visa.
